**The Norwegian Simulatorforum has since 2005 build up a competence on simulators that range from requirement specifications in the tender phase, to the instructors method of reporting after the end of exercises. We would like to share this competence with you. Therefore, you are more than welcome to contact us.**

## History

The first meeting regarding establishing of a Simulator- forum was arranged at the premises of Trygg Trafikk (The Norwegian Council for Road Safety) on the 23. November 2004. The initiator was executive director at that time, Leif A. Ellevset.

The establishment meeting was held at Gardermoen in Mars 2005, including a visit to SAS Flight Academy and test-driving of a flight simulator.

NSF was formally founded at a meeting in May 2005, and the first members meeting took place at Sessvollmoen in October the same year, and included test-driving of a truck simulator.

In March 2006 NSF arranged its annual meeting at Haakonsvern in Bergen (Norway), including test-driving of several maritime simulators. A member's trip was made to Sweden in August and included visits to VTI in Linköping and Trafikcenter Scantec in Kumla.

In March 2007 the annual meeting was held in Trondheim and included a visit to SINTEF. A members trip was made to Sandnes in September the same year, including a visit to Rogaland Cranescool and Motrans Trucksimulator.

In March 2008 the annual meeting was held in Drammen, including a visit to the school of NSB and test-driving of their train simulators. A members trip was made to Corys T.e.s.s in Grenoble, France in october 2008.

In march 2009 the annual meeting was held in Tromsø and included a visit to the University, AutoSim and the Maritime School. A members trip was made to Denmark and TSU in Vejle in September 2009. We got an presentation of their educational model, who was very interesting.

The annual meeting in 2010 was held in Gardermoen (Oslo Airport) in april. We was visiting Norwegian Armed forces on Sessvollmoen camp, for demonstration and driving the truck simulator and demonstration of the the medical simulator.

A members trip was made to Germany in september 2010 and Krauss-Maffei Wegmann (KMW) and the Technical University in Munich.

The annual meeting in 2011 was held in Stjørdal in april. A day with educational theme was arranged in a cooperation with The University College of North-Trøndelag. The day after we was visiting "the Educational office of Transport and logistic" in Trondheim where we got an presentation and test driving of the trucksimulator.

The board states the importance of a strategic plan to be developed so that the board, and NSF, can be able to set the right course for the future. The resolution for the plan of strategic was done in 2008.
